

## YOUR TAJWEED MADE EASY

A step by step guide to basic Tajweed rules

### LESSON 4 LENGTHEN FOR 1 SECOND (2)

If you see any one of the following 3 signs on a letter then lengthen that sound for 1 second.  
Standing fatha (karri zabar), standing kasra (karri zer) and upside down dhamma (ulti pesh).

لَهُ - مَالُهُ - إِنَّهُ

بِهِ - نَفْسِهِ - قَوْمِهِ

ذَلِكَ - آخِرٌ - سَمَوَاتٍ

عَلَى	نَفَّثَتْ	رَزَقْنَهُمْ	آخِرَةٌ	١ Any Letter Any letter with standing Fatha (karri zabar) on it
قُرْآنٍ	كَتَبَ	أَصْحَابُ	أَدَمَ	
أَيْتِهِ	هَذِهِ	الْفِهُمُ	نَفْسِهِ	١ Any Letter Any letter with standing Kasra (karri zer) under it
أُمِّهِ	أَهْلِهِ	ظَهْرِهِ	بَيْتِهِ	
إِمْرَأَتِهِ	دَاوُدَ	كَتَبَهُ	يَرَهُ	٦ Any Letter Any letter with Upside down Dhamma (ulti pesh) on it
نَادِيَهُ	نِعْمَتَهُ	فَضْلَهُ	حَوْلَهُ	

The key thing to remember is lengthen each example above for 1 second.

The sound has to be longer than just a fatha (zabar), kasra (zer) and dhamma (pesh) on a letter.

When you pronounce the following examples there should be a clear difference:

كَتَبَهُ - كِتَبَهُ	هَذِهِ - هَذِيْهِ	آخِرَةٌ - آخِرِيْهِ
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
